

Code of Conduct Agreement

FFWBC Sunshine Mission Week is excited to have you & your group be a part of our week of ministry. One of the unique aspects of FFWBC Sunshine Mission Week is that you and your students will worship, work, eat, lodge, and participate in mission activities with other youth groups from different churches and denominations located from different regions of the United States. As we partner together in Christian service, we strive to create a safe, respectful environment where each individual can grow in faith.

We want everyone to have a positive experience, so we ask each participant to follow this Code of Conduct Agreement. Please discuss this Code of Conduct Agreement with every student, parent, and adult leader before you come to camp so each person commits to safe and respectful behavior. We also ask each person to follow any additional campus or worksite rules specific to each days activities to maintain safety, punctuality, and respect. These camp specific rules will be shared at orientation after you arrive at camp, and they include restrictions on cell phone usage, the lights-out policy, and safety on the worksite.

- 1. Sunshine Mission Week dress code is loose-fitting unaltered t-shirts and loose-fitting fingertip length shorts. Close-toed shoes must be worn on the mission project worksite. Undergarments should not be visible and clothing should be properly fastened. Hemlines on shorts or skirts must be at least fingertip length. We do not allow tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts, halter tops, tube tops.
- 2. Sunshine Mission Week does not permit the use of alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs at the FFWBC campus or any associated Sunshine Mission Week activities, or ministry partner facilities or work sites.
- 3. Sunshine Mission Week asks each participant to be respectful of other people, other groups, and staff. FFWBC does not permit offensive language or profanity; behavior that interferes or threatens camp activities; behavior that threatens the health or safety of another person; or pranks that harass another person or damage property. Individuals or groups will be held responsible for destruction or damage to property.
- 4. Sunshine Mission Week discourages public displays of affection and discourages students from isolating themselves from their group, adult leaders, or camp activities. Sexual advances and verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature is not permitted.

By signing this document, I agree to review these policies with all students, parents, and adult leaders. I also commit myself and each member of my group to abide by this Code of Conduct. I agree to cooperate with Sunshine Mission Week Staff to resolve any issues in a timely manner.
